Household Hazardous Waste Drop-off Days **Saturday and Sunday, October 28 - 29 at Polytechnic Institute**

Public Works Director George L. Winfield today announced that the city's fall **Household Hazardous Waste drop-off days** are scheduled for **Saturday and Sunday, October 28th and 29th**.

This semi-annual event allows residents to rid their homes - basements, garages, and storage sheds - of hazardous household material by dropping it off at the Polytechnic Institute parking lot, located at Falls Road and Cold Spring Lane. Items will be collected from **9 a.m. until 3 p.m. on October 28, and from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m. on October 29.**

This cleaning event provides an opportunity to properly dispose of materials such as bleach, pesticides, herbicides, car and household batteries, propane tanks, drain cleaner, gasoline, pool chemicals and many other items.

Citizens should note that these materials must be taken to the Polytechnic location and will not be collected from your home. Proof of city residency, e.g. a driver's license, telephone bill or tax bill, is required to drop off items, and you must be able to identify the material.
